Clay County Supervisor of Elections Provides COVID-19 Update

Beginning Friday, March 20, 2020, out of an abundance of caution, the Clay County Supervisor of Elections Office will allow only limited public access to its building. We encourage citizens and candidates to use the Supervisor of Elections website, ClayElections.gov, as the majority of tasks, such as registering to vote, confirming or updating your registration status, requesting a Vote by Mail Ballot, updating a signature, and more, can be completed online. Staff is also available by phone or email during regular business hours.

Candidates, or prospective candidates, can file to run for office and submit monthly financial reports online at ClayElections.gov. Political committees, or prospective committees, can file or create a new political committee, and submit monthly financial reports on our site as well.

Citizens wanting to do business in person with the Elections Office, or candidates wishing to submit Candidate Petitions for verification, should contact our office to make an appointment. Appointments should be made the day prior, but a minimum of 3 hours in advance is needed, to ensure staff availability.

All public canvassing board activities for the Presidential Preference Primary currently scheduled will continue as noticed.

The safety of our staff and the public comes above all else. The Elections Office will continue to monitor and adapt to the situation and communicate any changes, as soon as possible. The public is encouraged to stay informed and aware by visiting the Florida Department of Health's new [COVID-19 Case Dashboard](#) which will be updated twice daily.
